LOCATION, TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

LOCATION: Eccleston Village Hall, Eccleston, Chester, CH4 9HT

Getting there. The website has details and the postcode works. Eccleston village is 3 miles South of Chester.

This is a wonderful huge village hall with loads of space, so there will be a learning area and a practice area for you. There is easy parking and we are right by the river Dee if it gets warm enough to sit in the gardens.

Arriving By Car

You will travel out of Chester on Eaton Road – crossing the river Dee and continuing south out of Chester. You will come to Eccleston village where you will turn to your left, go past St Mary's Church on your left and the village Hall is towards the end of the road on your right. There is loads of parking at the Hall.

Arriving by Train

The Saturday start is 11:30 and the Sunday finish is 17:00. There are direct trains from London which take around 2 hours and run regularly. Open returns are around £90 and can be slightly cheaper if you book specified trains.

Eccleston Hall is about three miles (£10) taxi journey from the station. Those travelling by train share taxis to share costs.

FACILITIES

- There are toilets where you can change.
- There is a kitchen if you need to store / prepare food.
- There is a fridge & microwave.
- There is also a big, beautiful garden.

FOOD

- There will be tea / decent coffee / biscuits/ fruit at the Hall.
- **There are no shops in Eccleston, so you will need to bring any snacks / lunch with you each day.**

PLACES TO STAY

BOOK AHEAD!! CHESTER CAN GET BOOKED UP...

Chester is a tourist city so there is loads of accommodation in every price range.

If you are arriving by train stay within walking distance of the station so you can meet / drop-off at the station for taxi sharing.

Chester is a very small city so anything close to the city is no more than a 20 minute walk from the centre.

Chester itself has all the usual chain hotels – try booking.com for them.

Personally I would use Airbnb – much cheaper and I enjoy staying in peoples' houses / smaller places.

Recommendations from previous groups:

If you are coming by train and want to be closer to the station for taxi sharing:

BABA Guest House, Hoole Road @£55, 10 – 15 mins walk to station

Chester Court Hotel, Hoole Road, @ £80, 10 – 15 mins walk to station

Bowman Lodge, Hoole Road, @£30 - £35, 10 – 15 mins

Brookside Hotel, Brook Lane, @ £55-£60, 15 – 20 mins walk to station

Queen's Hotel, Station Road, @£80 - £200, next to the station

Airbnb Sella Street 'Charming City Centre Home', Host Jane £45 - £50.

Airbnb generally – at least 20 in centre with many less than £50.

Roomzz, Nun's Road @£50 - £99 minimum with discount voucher. 20 mins walk to station

Quarterz Apart Hotel @£35 – very close to station. Great if you are sharing as bedrooms are in apartments!!

Check arrangements before booking!

If you are coming by car:

If you want to stay closer to Eccleston the closest accommodation areas south of Chester are Eaton Road, Handbridge and Hough Green. If you are driving, check there is parking where you are staying!

Sycamore Guest House, Handbridge £50 - £75. On the south side of Chester so good to getting to Eccleston.

Mitchells of Chester, Hough Green, £60. On the south side of Chester so good to getting to Eccleston.

Holiday Inn Ellesmere Port. Ellesmere Port is a lot cheaper than Chester but it is a good 30 mins drive and you'll need your sat nav to make the journey across Chester and out to Eccleston.

Holiday Inn, Chester @ £60 on outskirts of Chester
